
## Place Names Act

## NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the road shown hatched on the map in the Schedule be Bree Street, Fowlestone Road, Coffey Street and Duffield Street.

Bree Street named in commem-

named in commemoration of James (Jerry) and Mary (May) Bree who in the early 1990s moved to Darwin to be with their children. The Bree's became active members of the Palmerston community. May died in 2004 and James in 2005.

2004 and Jerry in 2006;

Fowlestone Road named in commemoration of George and Iris

Fowlestone who arrived in Darwin in 1946, living in a Sidney Williams hut at the Nightcliff camp. George worked as a plumber until he retired in his early 70s.

George died in 1978;

Coffey Street named in commemoration of Dennis Coffey (c1942-

1996) Correctional Service Officer; and

Duffield Street named in commemoration of Arthur (Art) Duffield (1924-

2004), ex-serviceman and a PMG worker who came to the Territory in the late 1950s on a 3 year contract and never left. He was a founding, life and committee member and Commodore of the Darwin Sailing Club.
