NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that:

- (a) the roads for Bellamack Stage 2B shown hatched on the map in Schedule 1 be named Clarke Street, Kieran Street, Doody Street, Smith Court and Flynn Circuit; and
- (b) the roads for Bellamack Stages 2C and 2D shown hatched on the map in Schedule 2 be named Bennett Street, Groves Street, McGrath Street, Henscke Street, Eucharia Street and Forrest Parade.

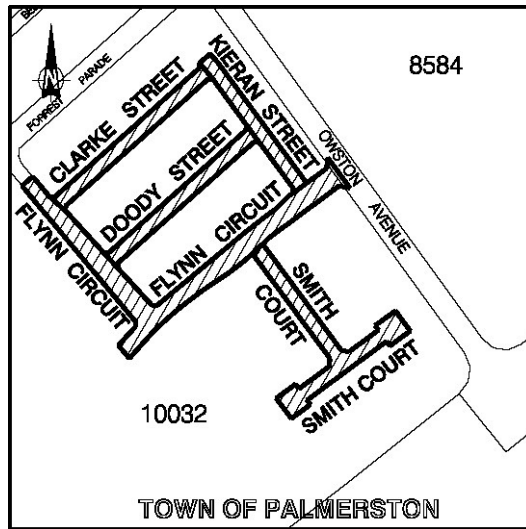
