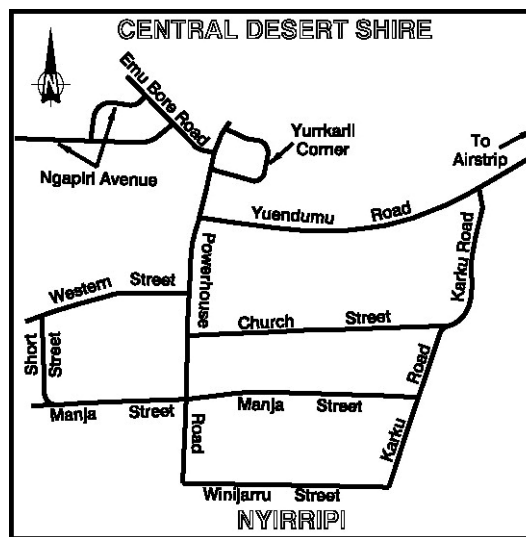
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown by thick black lines on the map in the Schedule be named Emu Bore Road, Ngapiri Avenue, Yurrkarli Corner, Yuendumu Road, Church Street, Powerhouse Road, Western Street, Short Street, Manja Street, Karku Road and Winijarru Street.

NOTE:

Emu Bore Road

being the road to Emu Bore;

Ngapiri Avenue

being the Warlpiri word for Gum Tree;

Yurrkarli Corner

being the Warlpiri word for Bloodwood Tree;

Yuendumu Road

being the road to Yuendumu;

Church Street

being the road where the church is;

Powerhouse Road

being the road to the powerhouse;

Western Street

being located on the western side of the Community;

Short Street

being a short street;

Manja Street

being the Warlpiri word for Mulga Tree;

Karku Road

being the Warlpiri word for Red Oak Tree; and

Winijarru Street

after the Winijarru Mountain to the south of Nyirripi.
