
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

NOTE: AMANS PLACE is named in commemoration of Jean Edna Amans (1913 – 2002), racehorse owner and trainer, and was a resident of Terrace Gardens Aged Care Home, Palmerston when she died.

- DEANE CRESCENT is named in commemoration of George Price Deane, a member of the NT Survey Expedition to Palmerston in 1869.
- VISENTIN STREET is named in commemoration of Luigi Visentin, who emigrated from Latisana, Italy in 1951. Founder and first president of the Darwin Italian Association. He was heavily involved in constructing many roads and subdivisions of Darwin, post Cyclone Tracy.
