NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that:

- (a) the roads shown hatched on the map in Schedule 1 be named Sheathtail Road, Kultarr Road, Quoll Court, Dunnart Court, and Numbat Court; and
- (b) the road shown hatched on the map in Schedule 2 be named Bettong Road.

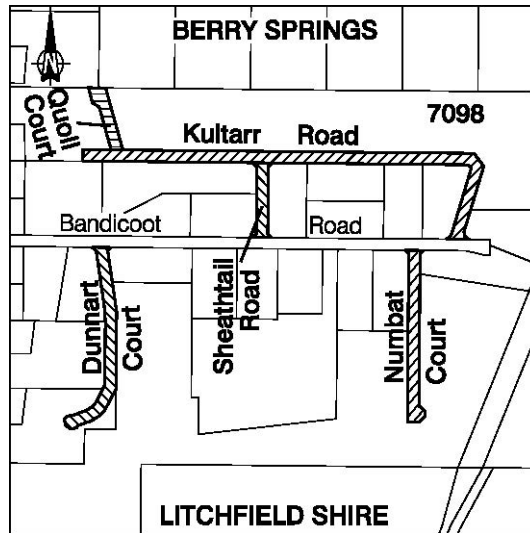

<i>Dunnart Court</i>	<i>after the sandhill dunnart, a carnivorous marsupial;</i>
<i>Numbat Court</i>	<i>after the numbat, a small mammal; and</i>
<i>Bettong Road</i>	<i>after the brush-tailed bettong and burrowing bettong.</i>
