
## Place Names Act

## NAMING OF PLACE

Albrecht Drive named in commemoration of Pastor Frederich

Wilhelm Albrecht, MBE (1894-1984) who worked with Aboriginal people in Central Australia from

1926 to 1963,

Teague Crescent named in commemoration of Violet Teague (1872-

1951, a Melbourne Artist who with others raised funds in 1933 to build a pipeline from Kuprilya Springs to the Hermannsburg community, and

Wright Place named in commemoration of Daffodil (Daff) Wright

(nee Sandford) (1900-1981), pioneer station woman who started the first laundry in Alice

Springs.
