

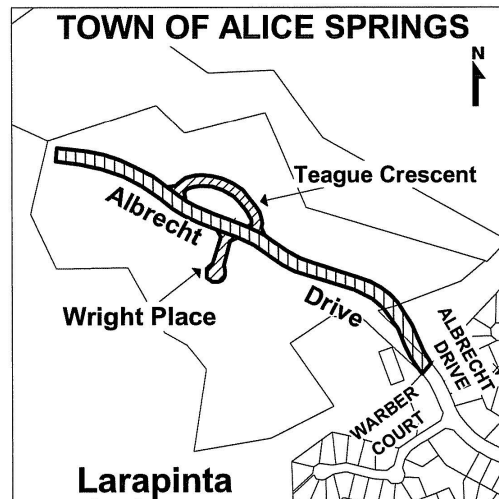
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Albrecht Drive, Teague Crescent and Wright Place as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

Albrecht Drive

named in commemoration of Pastor Frederich Wilhelm Albrecht, MBE (1894-1984) who worked with Aboriginal people in Central Australia from 1926 to 1963,

Teague Crescent

named in commemoration of Violet Teague (1872-1951, a Melbourne Artist who with others raised funds in 1933 to build a pipeline from Kuprilya Springs to the Hermannsburg community, and

Wright Place

named in commemoration of Daffodil (Daff) Wright (nee Sandford) (1900-1981), pioneer station woman who started the first laundry in Alice Springs.
