


Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown by thick black lines on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Wright Road and Yorky Couty as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

WRIGHT ROAD named in commemoration of Samuel (Sammy) Wright (1947–2002), an Aboriginal stockman who worked mainly in the Top End buffalo industry.

YORKY COURT named in commemoration of William Anderson “Yorky Billy” (1897-1979), an Aboriginal buffalo skinner who worked in the Marrakai and Kakadu area in the 1930s.
