

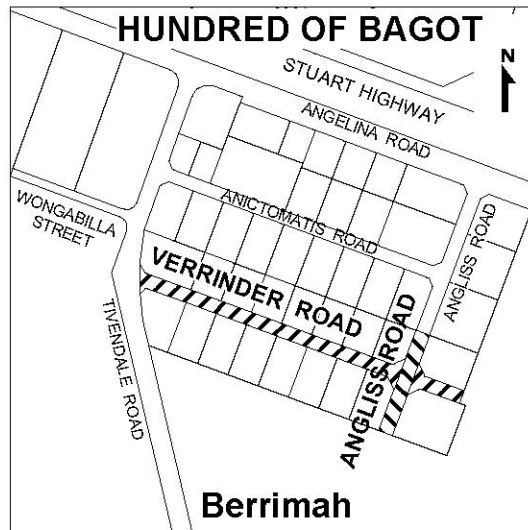
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Angliss Road and Verrinder Road, as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

ANGLISS ROAD is named in commemoration of Sir William C Angliss, head of the abattoir business which used to operate from this site,
VERRINDER ROAD is named in commemoration of Gilbert (Bert) Frederick Verrinder (1903-1987), an English immigrant who was with the Commonwealth Railway for 27 years, working on the line from Darwin through to Larrimah
