NAMING OF PLACE
APLIN ROAD

I, Peter Glen Chandler, Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment:

(a) under section 11(1)(a) of the Place Names Act and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act, revoke the approval dated 15 December 1999, published in Gazette No. G2 of 19 January 2000, of the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee in relation to the naming of Alpin Road: and

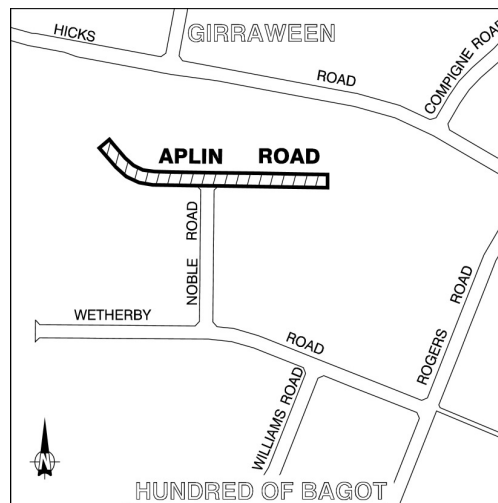
(b) under section 11(1)(a) of the Place Names Act, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the place in Girraween, Hundred of Bagot, shown on the diagram in the Schedule, be given the name Aplin Road.
