## NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the bridges at the intersection of Tiger Brennan Drive and Stuart Highway in Palmerston be named as follows:

- (a) Beekman Bridge being the road bridge over the inbound lanes of Tiger Brennan Drive (at Latitude 12°27'57" South, Longitude 130°58'24" East);
- (b) Graham Ross Bridge being the road bridge over the outbound lanes of Tiger Brennan Drive (at Latitude 12°28'05" South, Longitude 130°58'38" East);
- (c) Midpul Bridge being the pedestrian bridge over the Stuart Highway (at Latitude 12°28'12" South, Longitude 130°58'49" East).

Beekman Bridge named after Ron Beekman, an engineer who was instrumental

in major civil infrastructure projects across the Territory.

Graham Ross Bridge named after Graham Ross, a pioneer of the Territory trucking

industry.

Midpul Bridge named after Prince of Wales, a Larrakia artist who was born

with the tribal name Midpul.
