
## NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA *Place Names Act* NAMING OF PLACE

after Andrew Lennox, who was born in 1874. He was a missionary in the Northern Territory from 1899 to 1906. He travelled the length of Australia to start a Christian Mission in Kakadu, Northern Territory. He rode a horse from Adelaide to Darwin and a bicycle back again. In between teaching the word of God he survived skirmishes with luggers, crocodiles and mining companies.
