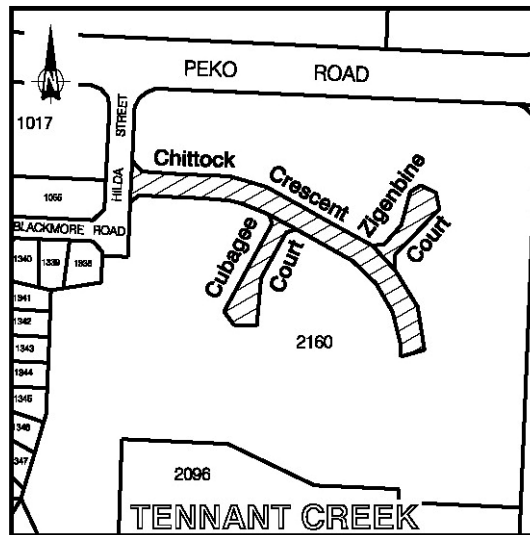
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown hatched on the map in the Schedule be named Chittock Crescent, Zigenbine Court and Cubagee Court.

NOTE:

Chittock Crescent

named after Alfred Earnest Chittock OAM, the first Mayor of Tennant Creek. He was Mayor from 1978–1988 and received an Order of Australia Medal in 1979 in honour of his work for the town of Tennant Creek;

Zigenbine Court

named after William Henry Zigenbine, a drover and stockman, who with his wife and large family was well known throughout the Northern Territory. In later years he settled in Tennant Creek. He died there in 1954; and

Cubagee Court

named after Dick (Kumbadji) Cubagee, an Aboriginal of the Warramunga tribe who inhabit the area around Tennant Creek. Cubagee accompanied David Lindsay, a surveyor, on his exploration trips into Central Australia in the 1886–1889 period. Cubagee died in Adelaide of tuberculosis at the age of 21 in 1889.
