
NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands:

- (a) under section 11 of the *Place Names Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument dated 2 March 2000 published in *Gazette* No. G11 of 22 March 2000; and
- (b) under section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the road shown hatched on the plan in the Schedule be named Katherine Close, as indicated on that plan.

Katherine Close is named after the Katherine River, which in turn was named by explorer John McDouall Stuart in 1862 after Catherine Chambers, the daughter of his financial backer.
