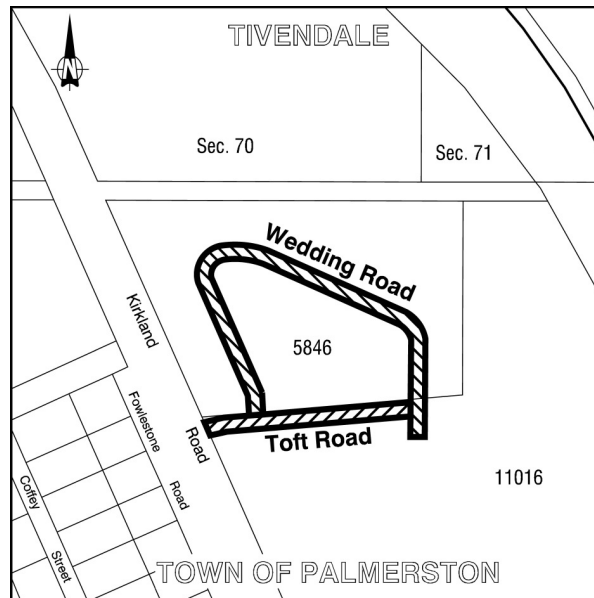
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Peter Glen Chandler, Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown hatched on the map in the Schedule be named Toft Road and Wedding Road.

Note:

Toft Road named after Patrick (Sonny) John Toft, a carpenter who travelled all over the Territory from 1964. He became heavily involved in repairing and rebuilding Darwin after Cyclone Tracy; and

Wedding Road named after Eric Wesley Wedding, who was a plumber and fire fighter in Darwin. Eric helped rebuild Darwin after Cyclone Tracy and did voluntary work for St Paul's Catholic Church.
