
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown by hatched lines and parks shown by dotted lines on the map in the Schedule be named McCormack Street, Benno Street, Ilentye Walk, Pepperill Court, Waku Park and Blabuk Park.

Benno played an integral part in establishment of the original living area, since relocated to the present site. The family have asked that his skin name not be used or published;</i> |
| <i>Ilentye Walk</i> | <i>Central Arrente name for pink cockatoo/galah;</i> |
| <i>Pepperill Court</i> | <i>family name;</i> |
| <i>Waku Park</i> | <i>in acknowledgement of the Waku family who first camped here; and</i> |
| <i>Blabuk Park</i> | <i>to commemorate the late Hamilton Downs Johnny Blabuk.</i> |
