
Place Names Act NAMING OF PLACE

Note:

Briscoe Crescent named after a well respected community leader and long term council man;

Pertame Street named after the language (one of the dialects of southern Arrernte);

Kwngelye Street meaning "dog" (southern Arrernte);

Lapadum Street meaning Dog Dreaming place;

Ghan Street named after the railway;

Erringka Street meaning a significant place for women; and

Putula Street being the original name for the Community.
