NAMING OF PLACE

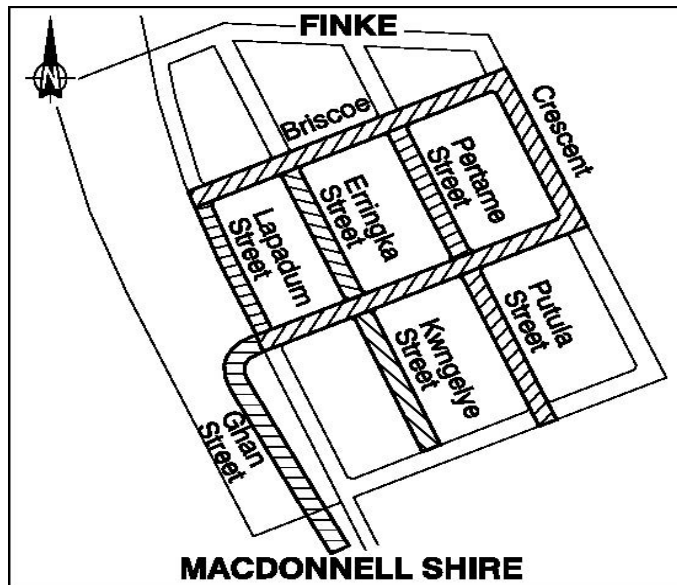

| <i>Lapadum Street</i>   | <i>meaning Dog Dreaming place;</i>  |

| <i>Erringka Street</i>  | <i>meaning a significant place for women; and</i>                               |
| <i>Putula Street</i>    | <i>being the original name for the Community.</i>                               |
