
Place Names Act

NOTE: Pelly Road

Named after the residence of the original owner of the land in Ormskirk, Lancashire, UK and later owner of the

land Percy Pelly.

McKinlay Road Named after the explorer John McKinlay. In 1866, John

McKinlay, explored from Escape Cliffs to the East

Alligator River mouth.

Lorikeet Court Named after the brightly coloured parrot which occurs in

large numbers around Darwin, where it feeds on the

various flowering gums.
