### NAMING OF PLACE

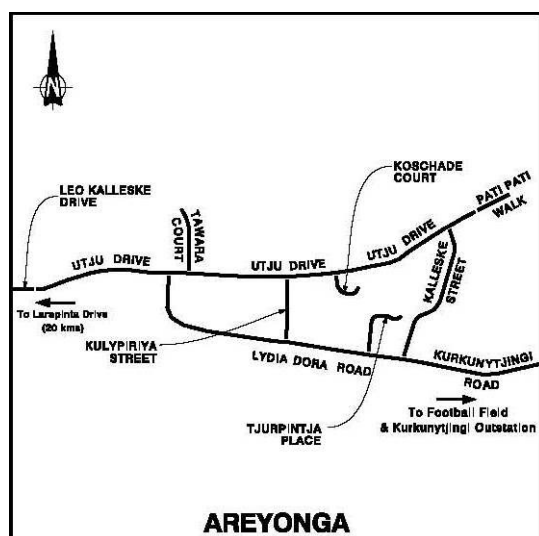
I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown by thick black lines on the map in the Schedule be named Leo Kalleske Drive, Utju Drive, Pati Pati Walk, Lydia Dora Road, Kurkunytingi Road, Kalleske Street, Kulypiriya Street, Koschade Court, Tawara Court and Tjurpintja Place.

NOTE:

Leo Kalleske Drive	after the late Pastor Leo Kalleske;
Utju Drive	being the Pitjantjatjara word for small narrow valley;
Pati Pati Walk	being the Pitjantjatjara word for end of road;
Lydia Dora Road	after the late wife of Pastor Kalleske;
Kurkunyjtjingi Road	being the Pitjantjatjara word for sweet honey on Mulga tree;
Kalleske Street	after the late Pastor Leo Kalleske;
Kulypiriya Street	being the Dreaming of Lady lives in caves at Utju;
Koschade Court	after Ida Huberta Koschade (1874 – 1972), Areyonga's first school teacher;
Tawara Court	being the Pitjantjatjara word for Men's Place; and
Tjurpintja Place	being the Pitjantjatjara word for swimming.
