Ebermilya Street	Named after a place (island).
Mamarika Road	Meaning “east wind” and a clan name.
Mamawuramanja Street	Named after a place.
Marrinamanja Street	Named after a place.
Mayarrmanja Oval	Named after a place.
Membirradikba Street	Named after a place.
Miyabama Street	Named after a channel.
Miyamurda Street	Named after a channel.
