TOWNSEND BRIDGE

I, Peter Glen Chandler, Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment, under section 11(1)(a) of the Place Names Act, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the name Townsend Bridge be given to the road bridge on Litchfield Park Road over the Finniss River in Charlotte, Hundred of Finniss.

*Notes*

- 1 *Townsend Bridge is named in commemoration of Henry (Roy) Townsend who personally constructed the bridge to improve wet season access to properties beyond the Finniss River in 1967.*
- 2 *The bridge has the coordinates Latitude 12° 58' 01.44" South, Longitude 130° 45' 36.37" East, based on the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94). These references are indicative only and not intended to define the precise extent or location of the bridge.*
