
NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA *Place Names Act* NAMING OF PLACES

Notes:

Cabrini Street	named after Sister Cabrini Lees, a mission cook for various Top End missions;
Damascene Crescent	named after Sister Damascene Callahan, a Principal of St Joseph's/ St Mary's School from 1933;
Eulalie Street	named after Sister Eulalie Ryan, a nurse who assisted with the leprosarium at Channel Island in 1955;

Flynn Circuit	named after Fathers Bill Flynn, John Flynn and Francis (Frank) Flynn, Catholic Priests who contributed many years to the care of people in the Top End, in particular Tiwi Islands, Port Keats and Darwin;
Gemma Street	named after Sister Gemma McCullagh, founding Principal of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Secondary School in Alice Springs; and
Laurencia Street	named after Sister Laurencia Enright, a teacher and Regional Superior of the sisters in the Northern Territory.
