

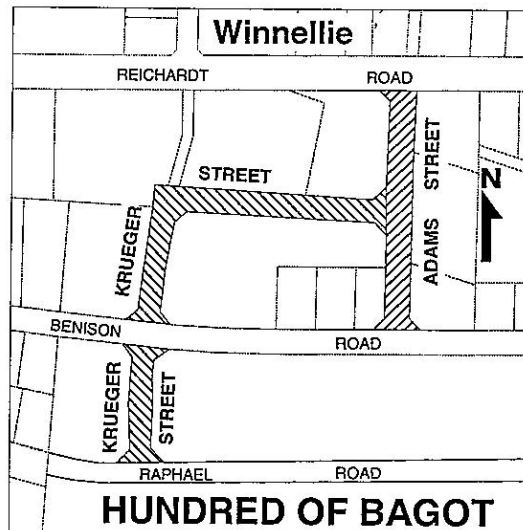
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Krueger Street and Adams Street, as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

KRUEGER STREET is named in commemoration of Wayne Raymond Krueger (1961-1985); Serviceman (Leading Aircraftman RAAF) and Prison Officer; killed in an automobile accident whilst on duty.

ADAMS STREET is named in commemoration of Charles Adams (1926-1995); originally from Thursday Island; worked as a labourer for many businesses and organisations including the Darwin Town Council and the North Australian Railways.
