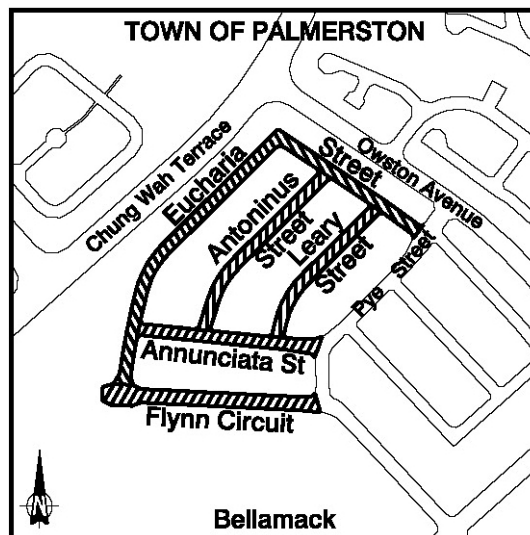
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown hatched on the map in the Schedule be named Eucharia Street, Annunciata Street, Antoninus Street, Leary Street and Flynn Circuit.

NOTE:

Eucharia Street

after Sister Eucharia Pearce, one of three foundation members to arrive at Garden Point Mission, Melville Island on 25 June 1941;

Annunciata Street

after Sister Annunciata Dew-White, one of three foundation members to arrive at Garden Point Mission, Melville Island on 25 June 1941;

Antoninus Street

after Sister Antoninus Shelley, one of three foundation members to arrive at Garden Point Mission, Melville Island on 25 June 1941;

Leary Street

after Father John Leary, whose first appointment in 1953 was to Garden Point Mission, Melville Island. In subsequent years, Father Leary founded a new mission centre on the Daly River, worked in Wadeye and Darwin, and in 1990 was appointed Vicar for the Aboriginal People; and

Flynn Circuit

after Fathers Bill Flynn (d 1964), John Flynn (d 1978) and Francis (Frank) Flynn (d 2000), Catholic Priests who served in the Top End of the Northern Territory.
